Ministerial Association sponsors 'Plant a Row for Hungry'

The Hoopeston Ministerial Association is inviting Hoopeston area gardeners to share their produce this summer and fall.

This will be the third year for the association to sponsor "Plant A Row for the Hungry," a program that encourages gardeners to plant a few extra rows and share the produce with the Grant Township Food Cupboard.

During each of the previous two years, Hoopeston area residents shared approximately 1,000 pounds of fresh fruits and vegetables with the Food Cupboard, said Bill Boose, food cupboard president, adding the

food cupboard has the capacity to handle large quantities of fresh produce.

Residents may bring fresh, clean garden vegetables or extra fruit to the food cupboard at 525 S. Market St., Hoopeston, from 8:30 a.m.-noon and 1-4 p.m. Monday, where food cupboard staff will weigh and record the amount of produce donated.

Started in 1995 by the Garden Writers Association, "Plant a Row for the Hungry" is a national program encouraging gardeners to donate their surplus produce to local food collecting agencies.
