Hoopeston Area parent/teacher conferences set Oct. 27, 28

Hoopeston Area schools will hold parent-teacher conferences from 4-7 p.m. Thursday, Oct. 27 and 8 a.m.-noon Friday, Oct. 28.

Due to high numbers, parents of kindergarten-sixth grade students need to make an appointment with their child's teacher to insure time is available for their conference. Parents of students in other grades do not need to make appointments; conferences can be handled during the scheduled times without necessarily making an appointment.

Any parent or guardian who cannot arrange their

schedule to attend during the scheduled times are urged to call their child's respective school and arrange an alternate time for a conference.

No grade reports will be sent home with any student. They must be picked up by parents at their child's attendance center during the scheduled times. This applies to all students.

All students will be dismissed early on Oct. 27. Grades kindergarten-six will be dismissed at 2:05 p.m. and grades seven-12 at 2:20 p.m.

There will be no student attendance on Oct. 28.
