Animals running at large issue dogs Rossville Village Board

ROSSVILLE—The issue of animals running loose in the village needs to be addressed, a resident told the Rossville Village Board Monday night.

Gary Danner attended the regular meeting after coming from Hoopeston Community Memorial Hospital where his wife, Vicki, was treated for a dog bite. Danner said his wife suffered puncture wounds in her leg after she was bitten by a pit bull while walking on Holmes. Danner said the dog also turned on two small children who were not injured.

Rossville is “no place for pit bulls,” Danner told trustees, wondering why the board does not ban the animals.

Village police officer John Beckley told trustees he was called to the area of 214 Holmes for the dog and that he had to use his taser to subdue it. The dog was then put in a cage and was expected to remain in the village until Vermilion County Department of Animal Regulation could respond Tuesday morning. Beckley said he tried calling Animal Regulation after the incident, at about 6 p.m. Monday, but that he got no response.

Mayor Terry Prillaman said the county eliminated overtime due to budget constraints so service is not available after hours.

Beckley replied that the dog proved “to be dangerous and they should have responded.”

According to Beckley, the dog, owned by Rosette Strawser, was chained in a yard when it pulled the anchor from the ground and ran off.

Beckley said he was reviewing village ordinances in order to write the proper citations to the dog owner.

Danner said his wife called the village office one to two weeks ago about dogs running and added he wants to call village officials each time a stray animal runs through his yard. “Are you willing to answer my calls
