cover the top of the vault or personal photographs or drawings can be used, providing a lasting tribute to the deceased, said owner Ryan Anderson.

Because the choices are limitless, each person's vault may become a personalized statement. "Take a farmer and a minister," Anderson said. "Their lives are totally different. Personalizing the vault allows us to reflect that "

One example Anderson has on display is a display of the first tractor his grandfather purchased. "We're farmers," he said. "This is important to us."

Using state of the art equipment, the photograph or drawing is scanned into a computer, then transferred to the vault lid.

When Anderson first added the service, some people wondered why place anything on a vault lid since it will be buried. However, Anderson said, after doing his first one and

hearing compliments from family members, he decided to offer the service to all customers for free.

Personalizing a vault lid costs Anderson about \$100 but he opted not to charge families for the fee, believing it adds a special touch to remembering a loved one. "I wanted to do this for my customers."






