Second mapping meeting focuses on attaining local goals

Hoopeston residents recently chose four areas in which to work to improve the city. At a meeting Monday, the group chose steps to achieve those goals.

At the second Mapping the Health of Your Community meeting, held Monday afternoon, more than 40 residents and community leaders discussed the four areas, which included infrastructure, business retention and expansion, downtown revitalization and housing. Using those as starting points, the group discussed specific areas in each as strategies for reaching the goals.

Under infrastructure, the top strategy was water tank repairs, fol lowed by water and sewer mains and high-speed internet.

Chosen under business retention and expansion were a small business incubator, business survey committee and learning center to provide training for a better workforce.
