# Hoopeston council works toward new TIF area for iron plant

The Hoopeston City Council unanimously agreed to move forward with a predevelopment agreement that will lead to creating a fourth tax increment financing area in the city.

At Tuesday night's special meeting, the council voted 7-0 to approve the agreement which will convert to a redevelopment agreement between the city and Vermilion Iron.

Under the proposed terms of the agreement, Vermilion Iron must agree to maintain a minimum of 15 jobs. In return, the company will receive \$80,000 in upfront funds when the TIF becomes active in July 2008.

The money will allow Vermilion Iron to purchase a heat treat furnace. Owner Mike Pentas told the council that the furnace will allow him to market Vermilion Iron to a different customer base.

The upfront money is to be repaid over 13 years at \$6,000 a year. Vermilion Iron will be eligible to receive \$355,798 in TIF-eligible expenses over the 23-year life of the TIF.

Under TIF guidelines, companies may receive up to 70 percent of TIF-eligible expenses. The money paid out comes from the difference between the level of tax on the property when the TIF is enacted and the amount of increase in property tax created by redevelopment.

In unrelated action, the council approved, in a 5-2 vote, leasing sports fields on city property to the respective sports organizations.

The agreements will allow sports organizations to create rules, which spectators must obey or face arrest.

The action stemmed from a request from sporting organizations which had requested that spectators not smoke near young players. Members of the organizations reported that spectators said they did not have to follow the request.

#### Council continued from other side

Alderman Charles Davis asked whether the action would force groups that wanted to use the parks to get permission from a sports group. "If this is about a smoking problem, why don't we handle the smoking issue," he asked.

City attorney Paul Manion said Davis brought up good points but said on the flip side, someone could hold a picnic in centerfield during the middle of a ballgame.

Alderman Carl Ankenbrand, parks committee chairman, said the leases are for the sports field and 100 feet around them, not for the entire park and that having the leases eliminates the need for an ordinance change.

Davis and Alderman Jerry Yonkers voted against the leases.

In unrelated business, the council:

- Approved the appropriations and salary ordinances and a wage adjustment of .085 percent for 11 employees whose raises last year were less than three percent. A new employee handbook was also approved.
- Approved, 6-1, a budget revision allowing the street/ alley department to purchase a leaf vac for \$25,000. Alderman Ed Lotz voted against it, saying after the



meeting that wasn't familiar with the situation.

- Approved a bid from Silver Brothers for \$3.23 per square foot for the 50/50 sidewalk program. Sidewalks will be 48" wide and 4" deep.
- Discussed but took no action on the possibility of adding part of Dice Addition to the city. Manion will research the issue more and will report back to the council in about a month.
- Heard from members of Realm of Shard, a medieval reenactment group which meets from 10 a.m.-2 p.m. Saturdays at McFerren Park. Speaking for the group, Chris Inman said rumors have circulated about the group and that one member was threatened at work for his involvement.
