Survey important in determining current, future needs

I was going to start this out by talking about how important the housing survey is to the future of Hoopeston.

It is and I'll talk about that in a minute, but I decided to start with what I think you might think is the most important thing and that is....

You can get rid of the name label before you tape it on your door to be picked up.

Whether you peel it off or cut it out doesn't matter. What's important is that you can get rid of it.

For those of you who haven't received your survey



yet, question 35 asks you to choose an income range for your household. I know a lot of people are leery to include that information so I thought it best that you know upfront that if you get rid of the label, nobody will know who filled out the survey.

Address labels are on the surveys because originally, they were going to be mailed. However, task force volunteers are now hand-delivering them and will pick up completed forms on Thursday.

In order to get that help, residents don't have to be dirt poor. Based on a mean income of \$31,900, a family with a gross income of \$25,520 is considered to be low income.

Based on the results of the housing survey, city leaders will plan for Hoopeston's housing needs but the information gained from the survey can also be used in other ways.

For example, the infrastructure committee, of which I am a member, is concerned about several problems including flooding and the condition of water mains and sewer lines. The housing survey will give us accurate information on how many people currently are on city water and sewer, whether services should be expanded and, based on the financial information, whether the city will qualify for grants to help fix these problems, including flooding.
