#### A tale of local thugs and terrorism

family will be destroyed. Your supervisor will betray your confidence. Is this the way Hoopeston should live? Do the thugs and terrorists win?

The citizens who stopped the assault, the good Samaritan who gave \$40 toward the purchase of a new tire, the rest of the supervisors who are supportive and pressed charges against the thugs as well, the citizens who came forward when they saw the vandalism to the vehicle.. These are the people who give me hope for our community. My hope is that they don't lose heart and that they don't have to be branded as Narks or Snitches and live in fear, suffer assaults and property loss because they did the right thing. I for one refuse to let the terrorists win. I am an adult who has yet to meet anyone who scares me. I am more than capable of defending myself and my family and will do so if necessary. It was my vehicle that was attacked, my family that was terrorized. That makes it personal to me and my family. Instead of ostracizing those who are honest, shine so bright a light on those who perpetrate crimes that they cannot stand it. They will change or leave.
