Police seek public help in Iroquois Federal robbery

Hoopeston police are asking for help from the public regarding a robbery at 3:21 p.m. Tuesday at Iroquois Federal Savings and Loan, 511 S. Dixie Hwy.

Employees described the robber as a white man in his early- to mid-40s, about six feet tall, of medium build and with short brown hair. He was wearing a light-colored printed shirt, blue shorts, a black ball cap and sunglasses.

Police said the man entered Iroquois Federal, demanding money. He produced a note and was given an undisclosed amount of money from a teller drawer. The man

put the money in a plastic shopping bag with printing on the side, then left the facility. He was last seen heading southbound on Rt. 1 in an older-model light blue Dodge or Plymouth minivan.

Anyone with information is asked to call the Hoopeston Police Department, (217) 283-5196; FBI, (217) 522-9675; or Vermilion County Crimestoppers, (217) 446-TIPS.

"We're looking at all angles," said Hoopeston Police Chief Mark Drollinger, adding his office is checking with other departments to compare similar cases.

Grant will fund Hoopeston pilot program to kick some ash

A Keep Vermilion County Beautiful grant is geared to helping Hoopeston residents who have a butt problem.

The problem is not with their posteriors but with the butts from their cigarettes.

At Tuesday night's Hoopeston City Council meeting, Kristi Hudson, KVCB member, announced that the city received a \$2,500 grant for a pilot program targeted at cigarette butt litter.

The grant was based on a scan volunteers completed on Penn St. from Third Ave. to Market, Hudson said.

"Well over 1,000 butts were found in that small area," she said.

The pilot program will take a four-pronged approach to solving the cigarette butt problem, including reviewing littering laws, educating the public through public service announcements, implementing "transition points" where ash receptacles will be located, and a follow-up survey to see if measures were successful.

In addition, 1,000 pocket ashtrays will be distributed in Hoopeston at events between now and the Sweetcorn Festival Parade.

"With the governor's law going into effect Jan. 1, we're trying to do a preemptive strike," Hudson said.
