Hoopeston residents to be focus of WILL series on WWII

WILL is doing a series of radio and TV reports and oral history interviews and events in central Illinois to create awareness and discussion about the impact of WWII on local communities, and to preserve this history before it dies along with the WWII generation. We are doing this through the power of storytelling and through local people sharing their oral histories from this time period.

AM-580 news director Tom Rogers has interviewed several people from Hoopeston, including Carolyn
