

# Iroquois clerk pleads not guilty to theft, misconduct charges

WATSEKA-Iroquois County Clerk Mark Henrichs has pleaded not guilty to charges that he deceived the county into paying for a vehicle he already owned and forged documents making it appear the vehicle came from a Chicago dealership.

Henrichs appeared in Iroquois County Circuit Court on Wednesday to enter his plea at an arraignment.

He had originally been scheduled to appear last Thursday but flooding in Watseka postponed his court appearance.

Henrichs was released on \$100,000 recognizance
