Main StreetTM is a philosophy, a program, and a proven comprehensive approach to downtown commercial district revitalization. This approach has been implemented in over 1,800 cities and towns in over 40 states across the nation with the help of the National Trust Main Street Center and statewide Main Street programs.

Illinois Main Street provides: access to expertise; a state-wide network enabling local Main Street communities to exchange ideas and strategies with their peers; State, regional and on-site training; and access to numerous resource materials and publications.

The success of the Main StreetTM approach is based on

its comprehensive nature. By carefully integrating four points into a practical downtown management strategy, a local Main StreetTM program will produce fundamental changes in a community's economic base. Simultaneously working in four broad areas, Design, Organization, Promotion and Economic Restructuring, a community can eventually realize a revitalized and prosperous Main Street.

These four areas, or committees, form our Main StreetTM program:
