Police said children were unloaded safely from the bus without injury.

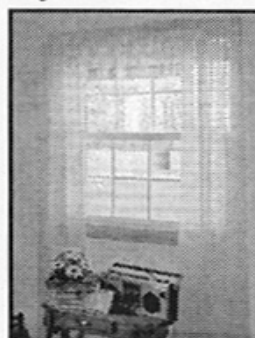
