Also, people who might be shy about asking for things will appreciate the anonymity within the group at large. No one will know the identity of the person requesting an item except the one "gifting" them, Lantis said.

"I feel Hoopeston is short on services of this kind, one where no money is involved at all, jus the kindness of people and willingness to share," she said.
