Hoopeston receives scaled-back Safe Routes to School grant

Hoopeston has one of 112 projects that will share \$8.3 million in Illinois' Safe Routes to School grant program. Hoopeston will receive \$12,350 under the enforcement category for speed feedback trailers in an effort to lower speed limits in the vicinity of schools.

Last year, the city applied for a total of \$681,525 in five categories. Besides enforcement, the categories included constructing, replacing or repairing sidewalks; making existing walkways accessible to disabled students; installing new or improved pavement markings; and creating traffic controls using traffic lights or signs.

Safe Routes to School, part of the U.S. Department of Transportation's Federal Highway Administration and overseen by the Illinois Department of Transportation, received 298 applications for 1,042 projects totaling \$77.7 million, said IDOT Secretary Milton R. Sees.

"It was a challenge for us to sort through so many worthy projects," he said. "We were impressed with the quality of the proposals."

According to a press release, to receive the money, the applying agency must complete the work, then apply for a 100 percent reimbursement from IDOT.

The Safe Routes program provides funding allowing communities to encourage safe walking and biking to

schools serving grades kindergarten-eight.

"The great thing about this program is that it not only provides resources so that local communities can make it safer for young children to walk and ride to school, but it also has inspired educators, parents and others to think creatively about how to promote a healthier lifestyle among our young children, said Gov. Rod R. Blago-
