School officials stress need for kindergarten pre-registration

The importance of kindergarten as a foundation for future success in first grade cannot be overemphasized. Pre-registration for next year will insure that adequate preparation has been made for your child before school starts in the fall.

Children who will be five years old on or before Sept. 1, 2008 are eligible to enter kindergarten in the fall of 2008. There are no exceptions.

No money will be collected during pre-registration. Kindergarten fees are payable in August.

Pre-registration for kindergarten next year will be held from 4:30-6 p.m. Wednesday, April 9 at Maple Grade School, 500 S. Fourth St., Hoopeston.

This pre-registration is for parents only. Please leave your child at home on this date. It is very important that your child be pre-registered so we may have an accurate number of children who will attend kindergarten next year. If you cannot make the registration date, please call Maple Grade School (217-283-6665) so we may add

your child's name to our list.

Please bring a record of your child's past immunizations. We need to know what shots your child has had and the dates they were received. Immunization against chicken pox or a doctor's verification that the child has had the disease is required. Physicals will not be given at the school. All immunizations and the physical must be completed prior to the first day of school. A physical cannot be done more than a year before the first day of school. The teacher will also need to know the name and telephone number of your family doctor.

Your child may enroll for half-day or full-day kindergarten. Our school district encourages the full-day program for two reasons. The primary reason is we feel the full-day program helps us provide a more solid background for students as they prepare for first grade. A secondary reason is the potential disadvantage that can possibly arise when some students enter first grade from half-day kindergarten and some enter fro a full-day pro-
