## County health department offers evening cholesterol tests

According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, all adults over age 20 should have their cholesterol checked every five years. Anyone with a family history of high cholesterol, heart disease, or high blood pressure, or who has existing medical conditions that increases risk should be screened more often, according to the CDC.

The Vermilion County Health Department is offering special evening cholesterol screenings to make it more convenient for people to get checked. The special screening clinics will be held by appointment only at the health department's Danville facility, 200 South College Street, from 4 pm to 7 pm on Thursday April 24, Thursday, May 29, and Thursday, June 26.
