## Hoopeston Area High School students face rigorous testing

Hoopeston Area High School students have a couple of testing days this week.

On Wednesday morning, freshmen and sophomores will take mini versions of the ACT Test. Ninth graders will take the Explore Test, while tenth graders face the Plan Test, said HA guidance counselor Kay Brown.

The tests measure

## Judge's wife faces sentencing on embezzlement from bank

URBANA—The wife of an Iroquois County judge who pleaded guilty to embezzling money while she was employed at a Watseka bank was set to be sentenced Monday.

Deanna Lustfeldt, wife of Gordon Lustfeldt, Iroquois County Circuit Judge, was expected to be sentenced Monday by U.S. District Chief Judge Michael McCuskey.

Mrs. Lustfeldt pleaded guilty on Sept. 4, 2007 to embezzlement by a bank officer and admitted taking \$18,000 from the First National Bank of Gilman's Watseka office.

She faces up to 30 years in prison but her defense

attorney is arguing that Lustfeldt should receive probation based on mental disorders that contributed to the crime.


In a sentencing memorandum, attorney Lawrence Beaumont said Lustfeldt had childhood traumas and postpartum depression after her third child was born and turned to shopping, becoming addicted to it.

Prosecutors argue that mental disorders are usually not reasons to not follow sentencing guidelines, stressing that Lustfeldt bought things for her daughters—which her husband did not provide sufficient money to pay for—because it made her happy.

Lustfeldt is originally from Milford.
