State changes requirements for student school health exams

Illinois has made changes to the health exam requirements for students for the 2008-09 school year. Students entering fifth grade will no longer be required to have a physical. State requirements will be that all kindergarten, sixth and ninth grade students must have health physicals before the start of school for students, which is Aug. 19, with the following exception:

• Participants must clean up all of their dog's solid waste.

 \bullet Participants are responsible for food and water during the event.

• Participants/dogs which, in the sole judgment of event staff, are in violation of the rules will be required to withdraw from the event.

• Participants must obey all posted signs and instruc-

Any child who received a health examination within one year prior to entering fifth grade for the 2007-08 school year (Aug. 21, 2006-Aug. 21, 2007) is not required to receive another health examination.

However, fifth grade students will be required to have a sports physical to be able to participate in sports for the 2008-09 school year.
