Vermilion Waste expands materials for recycling program

Hoopeston residents may now recycle more materials than ever.

Vermilion Waste has announced a more comprehensive list of things which will be accepted. The list is divided into three categories: mixed paper, cardboard and plastic.

The mixed paper category includes:

- Newspaper
- Magazines
- Telephone books
- Envelopes/junk Mail
- School/note/craft paper

- Computer paper
- Gift wrap

Included in the cardboard category are:

- Brown grocery sacks (must tear, brown or grey)
- Tissue boxes
- Beverage can boxes
- Frozen food boxes
- Food mix boxes/cereal boxes
- Corrugated boxes

The plastics category includes:

- Milk jugs
- Soda or water bottles
- PETE plastic #1 (typically, soft drink bottles, salad dressing, peanut butter jars)
- HDPE plastic #2 (blow-molded bottles and injection molded containers, both natural white and colored, such as milk, water, detergent bottles)
- V Plastic #3 (health and beauty products, household cleaners)
- LDPE plastic #4 (margarine tubs, frozen dessert cups, six- and 12-ring carriers)
- PP plastic #5 (yogurt cups, washed out syrup and ketchup bottles).

For several years, residents have been able to recycle clear, green and brown glass bottles and jars, aluminum cans, foil and trays and tin, including empty aerosol cans.

In the glass category, giftware, dishes, crockery, windows, mirrors and fluorescent bulbs are **not** accepted.

The expanded list puts local recycling in line with items accepted in Danville, said Kristi Hudson, local representative for Keep Vermilion County Beautiful.

Hudson explained that recyclables are collected in Hoopeston in garbage trucks. Items are then taken to Danville, where more recyclables are added, then to a recycling facility in Chicago.
