

Recycling continued from other side

For several years, residents have been able to recycle clear, green and brown glass bottles and jars, aluminum cans, foil and trays and tin, including empty aerosol cans.

In the glass category, giftware, dishes, crockery, windows, mirrors and fluorescent bulbs are **not** accepted.

The expanded list puts local recycling in line with items accepted in Danville, said Kristi Hudson, local representative for Keep Vermilion County Beautiful.

Hudson explained that recyclables are collected in Hoopeston in garbage trucks. Items are then taken to Danville, where more recyclables are added, then to a recycling facility in Chicago.

Because Vermilion Waste collects recyclables in

garbage trucks, some local recyclers thought the items were going into the landfill, but that is not the case, she said.

Recyclables in Hoopeston are picked up every other Friday. July 4 would be a normal pick-up day but because of the holiday, materials will be collected Saturday, July 5.
