spray local fields with fungicide, said Denny Glotzbach, location manager of Heritage F.S. Glotzbach announced the spraying to let residents

know what is going on and to assure them that the spraying does not pose a threat to people and pets. Pilots will observe a safety buffer when flying to diminish the possibility of fungicide drifting into yards or pools.

No insecticides or pesticides will be sprayed, he said.

With higher prices for corn, area farmers are spending more money to take care of their crops and, hopefully, increase yields, Glotzbach said, comparing the fungicide to vitamins taken by people.

While the spray does not pose a threat, residents will notice an odor from the product, he said.

Glotbach knows people will want to watch the lowflying planes as they pass overhead but warned that residents should be aware of how much time they spend in the activity. "Everyone should be mindful to limit their exposure to all kinds of chemicals, whether it be our products or what you use to wash your car," he said.


