Hoopeston Area lists information for beginning of school

Hoopeston Area schools will hold registration for the 2008-09 year on August 11 and 12.

CARE, ECSE and kindergarten through sixth grade students (Maple, Honeywell and John Greer) are set to register from 1-6 p.m. Monday, Aug. 11 at the middle school.

Middle and high school students may register from 1-6 p.m. Aug. 11 and 8:30-11 a.m. and 1-3:30 p.m. on Tuesday, Aug. 12.

Seventh grade orientation will be held at 6 p.m. Aug. 11 with ninth grade orientation at 7 p.m., both in the high school auditorium.

Kindergarten orientation will be held from 6-7 p.m. Thursday, Aug. 14 at Maple. Kindergarten students and parents should go directly to the lunchroom. Students should bring school supplies with them.

Registration forms are available on the school website (www.hoopeston.k12.il.us) which may be printed, completed and brought to registration to speed up the process.

Fees for the upcoming year are:

Early Childhood \$25

K-12 \$50

MS/HS Extracurricular Activities \$20/per activity, maximum \$40 per student, \$80 per family.

Additionally, all driver education students must pay \$50 for classroom/behind the wheel instruction. All seniors will owe \$10 for Newsweek magazine for Government class.

Parents are reminded that students entering fifth grade will no longer be required to have a physical. State requirements will be that all kindergarten, sixth and ninth grade students must have health physicals before the start of school for students, which is Aug. 19.
