Indiana man charged in connection with string of bank jobs

List includes local Iroquois Federal

A Newburgh, Ind., man is being held on charges that he robbed several financial institutions, including the Hoopeston branch of Iroquois Federal Savings and Loan.

Albert Byron Jones, 33, was being held in Parke County, Ind., for a string of bank robberies, including the August 7, 2007 holdup at Iroquois Federal and a July 3, 2007 robbery at United Community Bank in Danville.

He faces federal charges for those incidents and Indiana state charges for holding up PNC Bank in



Louisville, Ky., on Feb. 2, 2007 and First Financial Bank of Monezuma, Ind., on Nov. 14.

According to printed reports, Jones gave statements to law enforcement officials about involvement in an April 4, 2007, armed robbery of Bean Capital Banking Center in Wayne City and a robbery at an unnamed bank in Owensboro, Ky.

City couple receive probation for chaining woman to bed

A Hoopeston couple has been sentenced to 18 months probation after pleading guilty to chaining their niece to a bed.

Ronald and Barbara Schwartz were each sentenced to probation, along with 25 hours of public service work for their plea on the charge of illegal restraint, a Class 4 felony.

Hoopeston police responded to the couple's home on March 30, 2007, to find their niece, Paula Schwartz, calling for help. Officers reported finding Ms. Schwartz chained to a bed.

The 43-year-old mentally challenged woman has since been placed in a new home.
