Rossville Historical Society marks building's centennial

ROSSVILLE—The Rossville Historical Society is holding a museum open house on Saturday Oct. 18. The event will celebrate the centennial birthday of its museum building, the 1908 Ross Township Building.

The two story brick structure was dedicated in a three day celebration that ran from October 13-16th, 1908. Six hundred area school children participated in the festivities.

The building, located at 108 W. Attica, once housed

the Ross Township and Village of Rossville offices. In addition, in its 100 year history, it has been used as a township library and by the Junior Woman's Club of Rossville, the Saddle Club, and a temporary school room for typing and shorthand classes from 1947-1950 following the destruction of the 1898 Rossville High School. It has been home to the Rossville Historical Society since 1992.
