IDOT grant to provide transportation for area residents

The wheels on the bus go 'round and 'round...and will help area residents get to jobs in Danville.

Danville-based CRIS Senior Services received a \$258,000 grant from the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) to be used for a vehicle to provide transportation for Hoopeston, Rossville, Bismarck and Danville residents to jobs in Danville.

The grant is part of \$3 million in state funds to improve transit around the state, upgrading service for low-income workers and individuals with disabilities. Eighteen downstate agencies and local governments received grants which predominantly include a local share of

funding.

Grant recipients were announced October 7 by Gov. Rod Blagojevich. "These grants are going to make it easier for people who are working hard to improve their lives to get to and from their jobs and to support their families," Blagojevich said. "They will also provide more transportation options for individuals with disabilities that go above and beyond what is required under the Americans with Disabilities Act."

CRIS' grant will provide capital and operating expenses and will be matched by a \$258,000 local share.
