The Food Cupboard serves approximately 120 Families or 400 people per month. Most of these are elderly or young families, with an income below the poverty line.

Along with community donations, the cupboard receives staple goods and supplies from the USDA Commodity program and from local grocery sending their out-of-date inventory.

All donations must be in satisfactory condition; no dented, rusted or unlabeled products will be accepted.

The Food Cupboard is open on Monday and Friday afternoon, being staffed by volunteers.
