## State Sen. Dan Rutherford, DACC announce scholarships

### General Assembly Scholarship

State Senator Dan Rutherford (R-Pontiac) has posted applications for the 2009-2010 General Assembly Scholarships on his Web site, at [www.DanRutherford.com](http://www.DanRutherford.com).

Under Illinois law, each state legislator may award eight one-year scholarships per academic year. Senator Rutherford awards four to the University of Illinois and four to other state universities. The scholarships cover the cost of tuition for one full academic year.

Rutherford has established a Scholarship Advisory Committee of educators throughout the 53rd District to

review the applications and select the scholarship recipients. In addition to the application and letters of recommendation, the committee will consider activity in public and civic affairs and the relative financial need among the applicants.

Applicants must be admitted to one of Illinois' public universities for the 2009-2010 school year, and live in the district, which includes all or parts of Champaign, Ford, Iroquois, LaSalle, Livingston, McLean, Tazewell, Vermilion, and Woodford counties.
