For the second time in less than a week, police are investigating a local shooting.

Police are investigating the incident, which occurred at 1:50 a.m. Sunday in the 700 block of East Maple.

Police arrested Nathan W. Irvin, 49, of Hoopeston, on preliminary charges of aggravated battery with a firearm and unlawful possession/use of a firearm.

Irvin was taken to the Public Safety Building in Danville to await arraignment.

Three seek supervisor post

Boose said he brings knowledge and understanding of state and local laws and statutes pertaining to township administration and governance to the office, as well as knowledge of budgets, levies, experience, integrity and "an awareness of the changing face of our community."

Boose is a member of United Community Church, and serves on the board of Grant Township Community Fund, Hoopeston Area Ambulance and is president of the Grant Township Food Cupboard board.

Deck, 29, sees a lack of technology as one of the biggest issues facing the township. "Technology would enhance all aspects of our township government," she said. This change would be especially advantageous for the assessor's office by providing readily-accessible information.

Another issue is the lack of knowledge about functions the township provides. To bridge the gap and utilize technology, she would create online access to the township, allowing further insight. Many townships are already on line and provide a calendar with events and meetings, explanations of township ser-

The second issue is the need to computerize township financial records, enabling both the township and road district to be up-to-date and operate within or below budget. The efficiency created by computerization will save tax dollars, he said.
