close in 2008. As spring approaches and Americans gear up for outdoor activities, Keep Vermilion County Beautiful has planned an event to show continued support for the park.

Hundreds of volunteers, demonstrating their concern for the environment and in the spirit of service that both President Barack Obama and Governor Patrick Quinn encourage, will join together to Klean Up Kickapoo on April 25. The goal is to clean the park's campsites, pick up litter along the park's roads and cut

back the overgrowth on the park's many trails. A pond and lake cleanup will also take place under the direction of Kickapoo Landing.

The cleanup is part of Keep America Beautiful's Great American Cleanup, which takes place each year from March through May. During that time, volunteers throughout the country take part in the greening and cleaning of America.
