Using narrative panels and films, TRACES' BUSeum 3 is touring six Midwest states in spring 2009. One of its stops will be Hoopeston, when the bus-eum will be at Hoopeston Public Library from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. Friday, March 13.

In conjunction with the exhibit, a memory session is scheduled for 1-2:30 p.m. in the library meeting room. Dan Reed's Hoopeston Area High School advanced media class will videotape a panel discussion where people may share their memories of the German POW camp in Hoopeston.

German POWs held in U.S. camps were sent out to harvest or process crops, build roads and waterways, fell

trees, roof barns, erect silos, work in light non-military industry, lay city sewers and construct tract housing, wash U.S. Army laundry and do other practical wartime tasks.


With the high rate of German migration to the Midwest, many who worked with POWs spoke to them in their native tongue; some even had relatives or former neighbors among them.

Using 10 narrative panels and films about the story, TRACES' mobile museum (a retrofitted school bus called BUS-eum 3) will travel to schools, libraries and historical societies in the Midwest.

The bus is driven by Irving Kellman, who also talks to visitors about the exhibit.
