Hoopeston woman takes Ward 3 vote but can't accept win

Comstock does not meet residency requirement to run for office

Susan Comstock could have had a victory celebration last night but the write-in candidate for Hoopeston's Ward 3 said Monday that she is ineligible to run for election because she does not meet the state's residency requirement.

Comstock received 27 write-in votes in Tuesday's election while her opponent, write-in candidate Tony Hasbargen, received one vote, according to information provided by the Vermilion County Clerk's office.

Comstock, who previously represented Ward 3, moved from the area for a few years before returning last year, but not early enough to meet the 12-month residency requirement.

In another issue, Rossville voters reversed themselves from the November election and approved a referendum to pay for the new fire station.

The measure passed, 345-254, according to unofficial vote totals.

The measure was defeated by 13 votes last November, leaving the Rossville Area Fire Protection District without a way to repay the U.S. Department of Agriculture loan that funded the construction.

Need a Fresh Start? Come to New Beginnings Sunday Worship 9:30 a.m. Hoopeston Area High School Auditorium The district had planned to use a special tax levy to repay part of the loan but learned that state law bans using a special tax levy to pay a mortgage.

Had the referendum failed, fire officials had said the U.S.D.A. could have foreclosed on the building.

Another result of Tuesday's election is a new member on the Hoopeston Area School Board.

Lisa Leigh unseated incumbent Sara Johnson for one of two seats outside the old Hoopeston School District. Leigh's unofficial tally of 521 put her behind incumbent Russell Walder's 525 but ahead of Johnson's 460.

Incumbent Larry Jahn and newcomer Steve Highfill were elected from the area inside the former Hoopeston School District. Neither was opposed.

Ballots were counted from voters in Vermilion, Iroquois and Ford counties.

The school board will hold a special meeting at 7 p.m. April 30 to seat new board members and elect officers.

John Peterson was the winner of a four-way race for one seat on the Rossville-Alvin School Board. Peterson received 336 votes, followed by Jason Miller with 215, Tim Walsh with 171 and Angela Rome with 83.

Jim Weston ran unopposed in his congressional township but two others had no candidates.


