Restaurant owner responds to complaints on sidewalk tables

A request at the June 2 Hoopeston City Council meeting that outdoor tables outside L&M Restaurant cause difficulty getting down the walk brought the owner to Tuesday night's council meeting.

Restaurant owner Greg Mullen attended the meeting to respond to Gerald Minick's complaint at the previous meeting that he has difficulty getting down the sidewalk in his wheelchair because of the tables and chairs.

"I expected it," Mullen told the council of the complaint. "At this point, I feel like it's harassment and I'm getting tired of it."

Minick offered little comment at the meeting other

than telling the council "it doesn't meet (Americans with Disabilities Act) standards and that's all I've got to say."

Alderman Jeff Johnson said that while the city allowed Mullen to have the outdoor tables, "when it comes to ADA standards, it can't be 90 percent of the time. It has to be 100 percent." The act calls for 48 inches of sidewalk space to allow handicapped people to navigate and said he believes the distance will be increased to 60 inches. Also, a dip in the street in front of the restaurant causes the front end of cars to extend over the sidewalk. taking up sidewalk space.

The issue was referred to the street & alley committee.
