help the president.

That part of the lesson plan was dropped after the criticism.

Some school districts in the U.S. will shut down Tuesday, while conservative groups are urging parents to keep their children at home. Other districts are allowing students to opt out of the viewing.

Hoopeston Area students are not expected to watch the speech live. Instead, media teacher Dan Reed will download the speech and make DVD copies for each school building. Staff will review it to decide if its content is such that it can be used within a lesson at a later date.

President Obama's speech was to be made available on the White House web page on Monday. It will air live on C-SPAN and the White House web site.
