Hoopeston Regional Health Center to give gift to community

Hoopeston Regional Health Center is giving a huge gift to the community.

A 20 foot Giant Noble fir tree will be delivered to the city next week, part of Hoopeston's Christmas celebration, health center CEO told Hoopeston City Council Tuesday night.

The lighted tree has a three foot star atop it and weighs about 1.000 lbs., he said. Decorations will be created by Alderman Carl Ankenbrand's students at Honeywell School.

Survey conducted to determine eligibility for infrastructure grants
