Rep. Tim Johnson slams Obama plan to import terrorists


WASHINGTON, D.C.-U.S. Rep. Timothy V. Johnson issued a sharp rebuke of the Obama Administration plan to transfer terrorists from Guantanamo Bay to the Thompson Correctional Center in northern Illinois.

"This decision flies in the face of common sense, exposes the citizens of Illinois to a terrorist threat and violates what most of us consider immutable laws of military justice in our country," Johnson said. "I plan to use every resource available to me to fight what is yet another in never-ending series of ill-conceived policies of this administration. It appears this plan was hatched behind the backs of the Congressional delegation, not to mention the General Assembly of the people of Illinois.

Johnson has written President Obama to formally object and to urge the President to abandon the plan.


that he was confronted by Marcum while in his vehicle. Marcum allegedly broke the vehicle window, then punched him in the head.

"Importing al-Qaida terrorists to Illinois puts our people in peril," Johnson said. "Importing these terrorists means you're also importing their sympathizers and their evil crusade whose only reason for being is to destroy America.

"This administration has already signaled its intention to prosecute many of these people in civilian courts. With the Thomson Correctional Center in the Northern

District of Illinois, any civilian prosecution of these terrorists would occur there. Should a mistrial or other technicality derail that prosecution, that also means these terrorists would be released in our state. That's a very real possibility and one that I am not willing to risk."
