## H1N1 clinic at health department

Vermilion County Health Department will hold an H1N1 vaccination clinic from 3-6 pm Thursday Dec. 10 at the health department, 200 South College Street, Danville.

Children ages six months to 10 years of age must have two doses of H1N1 vaccine to be fully protected against the virus. Parents whose children have received their first vaccination are encouraged to access this opportunity to obtain the necessary second vaccination. Vermilion County Health Department records indicate there are about 1,300 children (ages six months to 10 years) in Vermilion County who have had their first vaccination and need a second dose. (Children under the age of six months cannot receive the H1N1 vaccine.)

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommends the two doses of H1N1 vaccine be separated by four weeks. Parents of any children ages six months to ten years who received their first H1N1 vaccination at

clinics held 28 days ago or longer are encouraged to bring their children in for the second dose.

This health department clinic will also be focused on the announced target groups of individuals who are most at risk from the complications of H1N1 influenza:

Pregnant women, who must bring a signed order from their doctor authorizing their vaccination; breastfeeding women who meet the target criteria are also required to bring a signed physician's order

People who live with or care for children younger than 6 months of age

Health care and emergency medical services personnel (EMT's/paramedics)

All people ages six months through 24 years

Those 25 through 64 years who have health conditions associated with higher risk of medical complications from influenza (asthma, diabetes, heart conditions, immuno-suppressed).
