Kankakee County officials seek help identifying found body

KANAKAKEE-Kankakee County Sheriff's Police are looking for help identifying the remains of a body found in Sun River Terrace in rural Kankakee County.

The sketches above were created from the remains of a Hispanic male found deceased in on April 1, 2009, by a man walking his dog.

The deceased man is believed to have gone missing in late summer or early fall 2008. He was found wearing khaki pants, a brown and yellow polo type shirt, brown shoes, and a ring. The man is believed to have been 35-55 years old at the time of his death.

3:39 p.m. Friday in the 700 block of West Honeywell. He was charged with possession of stolen registration decal and was taken to the Public Safety Building in Danville.


No tickets or injuries were reported in an accident at 2:12 p.m. Saturday in the 300 block of East Washington.


