# County health department schedules H1N1 vaccine clinics

Vermilion County Health Department has scheduled additional H1N1 vaccination clinics. The clinics will all be held at the health department's main facility in Danville, 200 South College Street:

- Wednesday, Dec. 30 from 10 am to 3 pm
- Monday Jan. 4, 2010 from 1 pm to 6 pm
- Monday Jan. 11 from 1 pm to 4 pm
- Monday Jan. 25 from 1 pm to 4 pm
- Monday Feb. 1 from 1 pm to 6 pm

Vaccinations at the health department are free. Children under age 18 must be accompanied by a parent. Pregnant and breastfeeding women are required to bring

a signed order from their physicians. Legal guardians of foster children must provide a signed consent from DCFS. Parents are reminded that children under age 10 who have had their first vaccination need a second vaccination 28 or more days after the first to have full immunity to the H1N1 virus.

The CDC lifted restrictive guidelines last week that had targeted high risk individuals, allowing anyone to get vaccinated. "We gave over 700 vaccinations the first day we were open to the general public," said spokeswoman Linda Bolton.

As of Friday, the CDC reported the number of hospitalizations and deaths from influenza like illness continue to decline. Only eleven states are now reporting widespread H1N1 activity. Illinois Department of Public Health said Friday that 2,502 people have been hospitalized with H1N1 in Illinois since April; 78 people have died.

To date, Vermilion County Health Department nurses have given nearly 8,000 H1N1 vaccinations during 14 clinics held in Danville, Georgetown and Hoopeston since early in November. "We have now moved our H1N1 vaccination clinics back to our facility to curb costs," Bolton said, adding, "Our vaccination system is designed to expand and contract based on need and demand; right now, it is prudent financially for us to do vaccinations at the health department".
