Clerk reports on new voting law

Lynn Foster, Vermilion County Clerk, is advising voters of a new state law that requires voting equipment to notify voters if they do not vote for every office on the ballot. This is referred to as an undervote.

If you choose not to vote for all offices listed, your ballot will be returned to you by the tabulator and a message will appear on the tabulator's readout, informing you of which offices you undervoted. If you have voted all the races you intended, you may have your ballot accepted as is by asking the election judge to override the notification. If you did not intend to undervote, you
