Hoopeston Regional Health Center offers DACC scholarship

Hoopeston Regional Health Center is offering a scholarship to Hoopeston Area High School students who wish to pursue a medical field degree from Danville Area Community College.

The amount of the scholarship available each year is be based on the cost of tuition, books and fees, with a maximum award of \$10,000 for completion of the degree program. DACC will directly bill Hoopeston Regional Health Center for the student's tuition, books and fees each semester. The cost of taking the prerequisite classes required for the program may also be eligible for payment.

Tuition will be refunded directly to Hoopeston Regional Health Center if the student receives a credit for withdrawal from one or more classes.

Appropriate documentation of the satisfactory completion of each semester's classes will be required before the next semester's costs will be paid.

Applications are available at Hoopeston Area High School. Interested students must complete the application and provide a written recommendation from the high school guidance counselor. A one page essay, entitled "Why I am choosing to work in the medical field, must also be included.

The application form, reference letter and essay should be turned into the high school guidance counselor before April 1.

Applications turned in after the deadline shall not be reviewed unless mitigating circumstances exist, as determined by the Chief Executive Officer. A student turning in a late application must supply a written request to have it included in the review process. The request should provide specific details of the mitigating circumstances that caused the application to be turned in after the published deadline.

Scholarship applications will be reviewed by an appointed committee. The committee may also request an interview with the applicant. The scholarship committee shall include the Chief Clinical Officer, the Human Resources Director and the Chief Executive Officer. In addition, up to three additional staff members may be asked to serve on the committee.

The student being awarded the scholarship will normally be awarded their scholarship during the school's annual recognition ceremony.

If a student becomes eligible for more than one scholarship the CEO will determine the amount to be dis-

Two Hoopeston men have been charged with burglary in connection with a March 1 report that several weapons and other items were taken from a home in the 700 block of East Young.
