it and it will be a tremendous help to the police department."

In other business, Prillaman told trustees that the village's general fund has been hit by late state payments and will be hit harder by 30 percent cuts proposed by Gov. Patrick Quinn. "We're going to be in a world of hurt in our general fund," he said.

Currently. Illinois is running three months behind payments in the use tax, four months behind on income tax and two months behind on personal property replacement tax payments, he said.

Prillaman also discussed the need to have the village water tower repainted at an estimated cost of just under \$50,000. The amount is up from \$36,900 for the previous paint job.

Prillaman said Illinois EPA regulations call for towers to be painted every seven to eight years. To do this, the tower will be drained, cleaned and painted inside and out. Work usually takes two to three weeks. "While it's down, you sweat blood that you don't have a major fire because vou've only got 200 to 300 gallons a minute going through the mains," he said.
