High school details schedule for state achievement testing

During the school day on April 28th and 29th all juniors in the State of Illinois will take the Prairie State Achievement Exam (PSAE).

The PSAE will measure how well students have mastered the Illinois Learning Standards. During these two days, students will be assessed in English, mathematics, science, reading, and writing. These tests are essential to their ACT scores as well as the academic progress of Hoopeston Area High School. These scores are required to be on students' transcripts in order to graduate.

Students will be practicing and preparing over the next few weeks before state testing begins. Please try to

schedule appointments in the afternoon on these test dates. Students will feel more comfortable testing with a group setting. There is no cost for the student for this exam. Scores can be sent to four colleges/institutions in this process

On April 28-29, juniors will be provided a special breakfast in the high school cafeteria from 7:45 a.m. – 8:05 a.m. The school will also provide snacks during the testing. Lunch will be provided at the completion of their off site testing at the Civic Center and Methodist Church.
