Assessor to remain Red Top Cemetery sexton at no charge

Susie Sheppard, Grant-Butler Multi Township Assessor, gets to keep oversight of Red Top Cemetery.

At Tuesday's Grant Township Board meeting, Sheppard questioned why trustees wanted to include a line item and salary for Red Top sexton, when she has served in the position since becoming assessor. Sheppard said when she became assessor of the multitownship district, she volunteered to continue as sexton at no charge to Grant Township. "I offered to do it," she said. "I'm pretty passionate about it."

Sheppard attributed the suggested change to an unnamed trustee's personal issues with her and said the board would have difficulty explaining to voters the need to spend money when she volunteered her services.

Trustee Dave Ervin said he was unaware of any personal problems between board members and Sheppard and Supervisor Bill Boose said the move was suggested to cover the position and salary should Sheppard become unable to fill the position.

In 1996, then-trustees approved a \$1,000 annual salary for the sexton position and added it to the assessor's duties.

The board approved including the line item in the budget but leaving the salary amount at zero.
