Hoopeston Area High School puts grad survey on website

Hoopeston Area High School graduates from 2005, 2007 and 2009 are being asked their opinions of the education they received at the school.

Students of those classes are being asked to complete an online survey hosted on the district website, <http://www.hoopeston.k12.il.us>.

Questions cover various aspects of school life and include:

Culture

- My school provides a safe, orderly and respectful learning environment.
- My school creates a sense of belonging for all students in an environment that is open and accepting.
- Students are able to achieve their academic potential without interference from external social issues related to alcohol.
- Students are able to achieve their academic potential without interference from external social issues related to drugs.
- My school's policies and expectations regarding appropriate behavior are clearly stated and consistently reinforced by teachers.
- My school acknowledges and celebrates academic and extra curricular accomplishments equally among all students and groups.

Motivation

- My school's students are driven to succeed and display a clear desire to do well in both academics and extra curricular pursuits.
- My school provides a teaching and learning experience that is challenging, exciting and meaningful.
- My school consistently acknowledges and rewards my behavior that meets or exceeds stated expectations.
- My school intervenes quickly and provides guidance to students who behave in a way that is contrary to our school's goals and culture.

Recognition

- My school has strong recognition programs in place that publicly acknowledge all students for their academic and extra curricular accomplishments.
- My school has strong recognition programs in place that publicly acknowledge all teachers, coaches and staff for their academic and extra curricular accomplishments.
- My school makes sure that all students are eligible for
