Hoopeston Area school district has announced dates for registering for the 2010-11 school year, which begins August 20. Dates are to remember include:

Wednesday, August 11

- CARE, ECSE and kindergarten-sixth grade will be held from 1-6 p.m. in the middle school.
- Special registration will be available for migrant families on August 11. Look for the Migrant Education table.
- Middle school (grades 7-8)-8:30-11:30 a.m.; 1-6 p.m.
- High school (grades 9-12) 8:30-11:30 a.m.; 1-6 p.m.

Thursday, August 12

• Middle school (grades 7-8)-8:30-11:30 a.m.; 1-6 p.m.

- High school (grades 9-12) 8:30-11:30 a.m.; 1-6 p.m.
- Freshmen/parent orientation, 6 p.m., high school auditorium

Tuesday, August 17

Kindergarten orientation, 6-7 p.m., Maple School. Kindergarten students/parents should go directly to the lunchroom. Students should bring school supplies with them.

Thursday, August 19

Middle school open house, 6:30 p.m., at the middle school

School Fees

- Early Childhood-\$25 book rental
- K-12-\$50 book rental
- MS/HS extracurricular activity fee \$20/activity, maximum \$40/student, \$80/family

The following additional high school fees are due at registration:

- Driver education students-\$50 for classroom/behind the wheel instruction.
- Spanish 1 students-\$10 for workbook
- Government classes-\$10 for weekly magazine

State requirements are that all kindergarten, sixth and ninth grade students must have health physicals before the start of school for students, which is August 20, 2010.

Students involved in sports are required to have a sports physical to participate in athletics for the school


