Letter to parents explains schedule change at HAHS

Editor's Note: Hoopeston Area High School Principal Larry Maynard requested this letter be printed, regarding scheduling changes at the school.

Dear Parent/Guardian:

As you may have noticed, there has been a change in the schedule for this school year. Our goal is to provide additional support and intervention to students who may be struggling to help them to meet their educational potential. We have added an ACCESS period that will allow your student to receive this support in a smaller group setting than a classroom. Students are chosen based on several pieces of information, including teacher recommendation, grades, and testing information. Your student may not receive this intervention for the entire year, or even the entire semester. Our hope is to encourage and foster independent academic success in all students. We will be monitoring student progress frequently to help in determining who continues to need support.



Just what is Mother Hubbard’s Trail?
Mother Hubbard’s Trail is a little bit of Indiana Jones and a bit of Amazing Race put together with some mind games, special places, simple tasks, a lot of laughs and great fun.
Throughout the trail participants will be given a bit of information on different places and will have to figure out where the places are and get there the best way they can.
Take a picture of specific items at the site or complete a task. At some sites, a task will need to be completed by one or more team members. Teams will be scored by the "Task Giver" and they will give participants instructions to the next site. All tasks are something that anyone can do. You must be 21 to participate. Must have items: full tank of gas; digital camera; money and a cell phone. Optional items: movie camera and/or GPS.
At trails end, food and dance and a time to share many good pictures and stories of your adventure.
An informational meeting about the event will be held Friday, Sept 17 at 6:30 to 7:30 at Hubbard Trail County Club, Rossville, IL - an information meeting with questions and answers about the event. This meeting is optional.
On Saturday, Sept 18, from 12:30 to 1 pm - teams will go over last minute instructions; receive packets. The event will start at 1 p.m.
