Hoopeston water customers now have options to pay their water bills.

At Tuesday's city council meeting, Mayor Bill Crusinberry said those options include paying by credit or debit card, electronic checks, checks by phone or online.

Fliers with the new information are available at the water department. According to the flier, to register, residents should go to www.hoopeston-il.gov and click on the "Register for Online Statements" tab. There, enter the customer number and first/last name or business name. Customers will then be asked to verify account information, then enter an email address and password, along with a secret question. Once that is completed, customers will go to their personal profiles, select the "online statements" tab and set up delivery options (online only or print and online).

Customers will be notified when a statement is ready for viewing.

Other options have been added for payments, including using MasterCard, Visa or Discover, echecks (withdrawal from a checking or savings account), by phone at (877) 885-7968.

Bills may be paid by phone 24 hours a day. Live customer service representatives are available from 8 a.m.-7 p.m. (Central time) Monday through Friday.
