HRHC, Carle's Mills Breast Cancer Institute team up for digital mammography services

To ensure the highest degree of accuracy in diagnosing or ruling out breast cancer, Hoopeston Regional Health Center (HRHC) will begin to offer digital mammography services beginning October 6 and is partnering with Carle's Radiology Breast Imaging Department at the Mills Breast Cancer Institute (MBCI) for Carle's team, including board certified, fellowship trained Breast Imagers to interpret mammography studies.

Digital mammography is similar to traditional mammography except the images are captured digitally rather than on film. This leading-edge technology is faster, reducing patient wait and exam time as well as results availability. In addition, this digital mammography technology will decrease exposure to radiation by 30 percent and creates higher quality images. The advanced imaging leads to earlier diagnosis, and even more precise treatment including surgery or radiation.

"Offering digital mammography is one of many ways we are incorporating advanced technology to enhance the accuracy and quality of care provided locally," said
