## Rossville trustees approve contract with electric broker

ROSSVILLE—Village trustees unanimously approved an 18-month contract with Direct Energy of Pittsburgh, Penn., to provide electricity to the village.

At Monday's board meeting, Mayor Terry Prillaman said had the village used Direct Energy over the preceding year, it would have saved \$3,100.

Under terms of the contract, the village will pay .062 cents, compared with .078 cents with Ameren. "I personally feel it's a pretty good deal for us," Prillaman said. "Eighteen months from now, we may wish we'd asked them for five years."

In other business, Prillman told the board that the

village will receive a \$100,000 grant to install an 8" water main south of the village, thanks to state Sen. Dan Rutherford. The village previously received a similar grant thanks to state Rep. Shane Cultra.
